MINUTES

1. DECLARATION OF OPENING

Cr T Chitty, Deputy Shire President and Acting Chairperson, declared the meeting the AROC meeting open at 9.40am.

2. PRESENTATIONS

2.1 WELCOMING REPRESENTATIVE – HON C PORTER'S OFFICE

We have been advised (26.09.2018) that Joseph Calabro and Nathan Cera will be in attendance at the AROC Meeting to discuss with AROC matters that AROC are concerned about, including, but not limited to the dot points provided to Hon Christian Porter's Office on 21 August 2018 as follows:

 Roads to Recovery – 18/19 has been reduced by half compared to what we got in 17/18 – preference to use the 17/18 formulae;

<u>Question Taken on Notice: Shire of Northam CEO thought that</u> the funds were reduced from \$600,000 to \$380,000

<u>(\$350 Million-400 Million per year 2019-2020 onwards)</u>

- Recommendations from ALGA as follows:
 - Supporting secondary freight network;

<u>Question Taken on Notice: Shire of Goomalling - Will review of</u> <u>Alice Springs occur?</u>

Financial Assistance Grants (FAGS); and

Feedback - Quantum needs to be increased.

<u>Feedback - Timing of FAGS in terms of Budgeting is oddly</u> <u>timed and not consistent.</u>

➢ Review of State GST.

Discussion Points were as follows:

- State needs to be certain of 70 cent return. Certainty and definition
- Fairer GST deal.
- Sense of vision for his electorate.
- Identify a time for facilitating time separately for the Shire's that fits into C Porters time.
- Other infrastructure funding other than Roads to Recovery Local Government Community Infrastructure Program

(C Porters Representative exited the meeting)

- Question: When contracts are up and running If there is a problem, do Local Governments deal directly with the Contractor? and
- Individual contracts will exist with individual service requirements, however issues can be approached individually or as part of the group.
