Toodyay is home to four true seasons. The landscapes change dramatically throughout the year and each change is beautiful.

Whether you visit for the green rolling hills, the cool foggy mornings or the quintessential golden summers, you will see a striking countryside.

Explore the magnificent scenery within the many nature reserves in and around Toodyay. Take an energetic hike or a relaxing stroll along the firebreaks to appreciate pristine bushland. There are many native species of flora and fauna to be found, including Wandoo and the black cockatoo.

The Avon Valley National Park features forests and granite outcrops with panoramic views over the Avon Valley, with the stunning Avon River running through the centre.

Walks & Wildflowers

Toodyay has many walking trails, and wildflowers can be found in abundance from August to October.

Noongar Night Skies

Australian Aboriginals are often credited with being the world's first astronomers. Aboriginal astronomy is an important part of Noongar history.

Worl Wangkiny (sky stories) - observing and interpreting the night sky has been used for navigation, calendars, ceremony, cultural lore, song-lines and art for thousands of years. To experience the wonders of the night sky the Toodyay (Duidja) region is perfect and known for its clear dark nights.







Duidja – Toodyay

For over 45,000 years Noongar tribes lived and moved across the Toodyay Valley. The name Toodyay comes from the Noongar word Duidja meaning Mist.

You can learn more about the area's Noongar history at places of significance including Red Bank Pool, Pelham Reserve, Duidgee Park and the Aboriginal burial ground at the Showgrounds.

Further interpretation exploring the impact of settlement on the Noongar people can be found at the Newcastle Gaol Museum.



European Settlement

Toodyay is one of the oldest inland towns in Western Australia and much of its heritage is preserved. The town was established in 1836, and as such many Western Australians have a family link to the town.

Toodyay's rich history can be uncovered by exploring the two museums or by walking the historic walk trails exploring buildings and memorials from the era of early settlement.

Where the Legend of Moondyne Joe began...

Moondyne Joe is infamous for his break outs from the Fremantle Gaol - but his escapee life actually started in Toodyay. Caught for illegally branding a horse, Joseph Bolitho Johns promptly escaped from the Toodyay lockup - taking the same horse he had branded plus the magistrate's saddle and bridle. The rest is history...

The tale of Moondyne Joe is brought to life at the Newcastle Gaol Museum.






