

Shire of Toodyay Infringement Payment Options

You must action one of the following within 28 days of the issue date:

1. Pay the modified penalty;
2. Advise the Chief Executive Officer in writing that you will not be paying the modified penalty because you wish to defend this allegation in Court; or
3. Appeal this infringement by writing to the Shire of Toodyay providing your name, address, infringement notice number and the details of your appeal. Remember to include relevant documentation to support your appeal.

If you do not want to be prosecuted in Court for the offence, pay the penalty within 28 days after the date of the notice.

If you do not pay the modified penalty within 28 days after the date of this notice, you may be prosecuted, or enforcement action may be taken under the *Fines, Penalties and Infringement Notices Enforcement Act 1994* (the Act). Under the Act, some or all of the following actions may be taken:

- your driver's licence may be suspended;
- your vehicle licence may be suspended or cancelled;
- you may be disqualified from holding or obtaining a driver's licence or vehicle licence;
- your vehicle may be immobilised or have its number plates removed
- your details may be published on a website;
- your earnings or bank accounts may be garnished; and
- your property may be seized and sold.

If you requested consideration for withdrawal, and that was denied, you have twenty-eight (28) days from the date of the 'Non-Withdrawal' Letter to take action.
